Community fireworks display (winter or possibly after MHS prizegiving)
Safe cycling routes to high school
Improve off-street parking in CBD

An equestrian academy
Develop and use the marae for more tourist attractions
Grooming and guiding youth to play an active role in community developments, projects, actions
Help and support women to get back into the workforce
Create more housing for young people, particularly young men
